‘Courts to continue with normal operations’

Kampala-July 2017: There are reports circulating that members of the Uganda Association of Prosecutors have a planned sit-down strike, starting on Wednesday July 12, 2017.

However, it has emerged from a discussion between Judiciary’s Chief Registrar, Gadenya Paul Wolimbwa, and the Director of Public Prosecutions (DPP), Justice Mike Chibita, that there is no planned industrial action by State Attorneys and Prosecutors.

“What you are hearing are statements from individual state attorneys and prosecutors that should be ignored, for they do not represent the official position of the Office of the DPP,” said the Chief Registrar.

All courts shall remain open on Wednesday (July 12) and onwards, according to the Chief Registrar. “The public should not be confused by anyone – our courts shall continue with normal operations,” said Mr. Gadenya.
