SUBJECT: ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVES TO GUIDE COURTS ON HANDLING

CASES INVOLVING ACCUSED PERSONS PENDING MINISTER'S

**ORDERS** 

Whereas the Minister's orders under section 113 (5) of the Magistrates Courts Act, Cap. 16 and section 48 (2) of the Trial on Indictment Act, Cap. 23 are aimed at ensuring proper medical and other treatment of mentally-disabled accused persons;

Noting that there is no procedure provided for returning a prisoner to court for appropriate orders where the Minister has failed or ignored to issue the necessary orders under the Act;

Recognizing that section 39(2) of the Judicature Act, Cap. 13 provides that where no procedure is laid down for the High Court by any written law or by practice, the court may, in its discretion, adopt a procedure justifiable by the circumstances of the case;

**Noting** that the Minister's orders under section 113(5) of the Magistrates Courts Act, Cap. 16 and section 48(2) of the Trial on Indictment Act, Cap. 23 are to be construed with modifications and adaptations to conform with the right to a speedy trial guaranteed under Article 28(1) of the Constitution;

And aware that there are accused persons who are mentally disabled and have been in prisons for several years without resolution of their cases;

Therefore, I issue the following administrative directives-

- (a) The Registrar-High Court for cases in the High Court and the Registrar-Magistrates' Affairs & Data Management for the case in Magistrates Court, shall cause certified copies of proceedings of all files in which the Minister's orders are pending to be forwarded to their respective offices within thirty days effective from September 26, 2022.
- (b) With effect from the date of issuing this Circular, whenever a Court makes an order remanding an accused person pending Minister's orders, the Registrar or Magistrate in charge of the Court making the order shall within thirty days from the date of the order, cause certified copies of the file to be forwarded to the Registrar High Court for an order made by the High Court or the Registrar, Magistrates' Affairs & Data Management for an order made by a Magistrate's Court.
- (c) The Registrar-High Court and the Registrar-Magistrates' Affairs & Data Management shall transmit all certified copies of the files received from the Courts to the Chief Registrar, within seven days from the date of receipt.
- (d) The Chief Registrar shall immediately transmit to the Minister of Justice and Constitutional Affairs, all certified copies of the court orders received in (c) above notifying the Minister of the existence of the cases.

These directives take immediate effect and shall be adopted in the interim as Practice Directions are formulated to guide the Courts on how to handle cases involving accused persons pending Minister's orders.
