#### **Assessing the Panel Courts**

In the case of appellate and other panel courts, the following scheme would apply;

- a) All Justices participating on the panel get the weight of the case as per the case category;
- b) The Justice who writes the lead judgment gets an extra 50% of the case weight as per the category;
- c) The Justice who writes a lengthy concurring judgment gets an extra 50% of the case weight as per the category;
- d) The Justice who writes the dissent judgment (if any) gets an extra 50% of the case weight as per the category;
- e) The case weight score for the single Justice applications are allocated to the Justice concerned in handling the case matter.

## 2.0 CASE COMPLEXITY - PROPOSED

The Consultant identified the following as Case Complexity Factors:

### **Case Complexity Factors**

- (i) Number of witnesses;
- (ii) Number of parties involved;
- (iii) Number of exhibits;
- (iv) Number of languages used;
- (v) Value of the subject matter; and
- (vi) Number of lawyers involved.
