The Applicants were among the administrators under Letters of Administration granted in Administration Cause No. 023 of 2017 (High Court at Mukono), and the said grant later lapsed on 31st May 2025. Upon lapse, the Applicants promptly applied for extension/renewal, and further filed an inventory/account in relation to the estate. Without consultation with the family and other beneficiaries, the Respondents procured a fresh grant at Lugazi on or about 1st December 2025 in HCT-29-FD-AC-0055 of 2025. The Respondents have relied, and/or threaten to rely, on the Lugazi grant to access, manage, and/or transact in estate property and benefits without the requisite consultation with, or consent of, the other beneficiaries, who are the rightful beneficiaries of the bulk of the unadministered estate. Unless restrained and unless status quo is preserved, there is imminent risk of waste, unlawful dealings, intermeddling, fraudulent registration, which may occasion irreparable loss. The Applicants have filed a suit to revoke/annul the Lugazi grant, and it is just and equitable that the estate is protected pending Court's determination. That the Applicants hereby undertake to abide by and comply with any order this Honourable Court may make as to damages, and to compensate the Respondent(s) for any loss that may be proved to have been occasioned by the temporary injunction, should this Honourable Court later find that the injunction ought not to have been granted.</p>	Hearing	Chambers of the Registrar
